LTC Miller attends the United States Army War College, Carlisle Barracks, PA. LTC Miller enlisted in the United States Army Reserve (USAR) in 1985 and reported to basic training at Fort Knox, KY as a Private (Armor Crewman); attended Drill Sergeant School at Fort Dix, NJ in 1989; and after attaining the rank of Sergeant First Class received a direct commission into the Transportation Corp in January 2003. After commissioning, he held various leadership positions as an USAR Active Guard/Reserve (AGR) and Troop Program Unit (TPU), including Commandant, (Readiness Training Academy, 83d United States Army Reserve Training Center, Fort Knox, Kentucky (AGR)); Chief, Army Element Branch and Army Subordinate Element Commander, (United States Transportation Command, Scott AFB, IL (AGR)); Secretary of the General Staff (79th Theater Sustainment Command, Los Alamitos, California (AGR)); Commandant, Regional Training Site – Maintenance (3rd Brigade, 94th Training Division, Fort Indiantown Gap, Pennsylvania (AGR)), Human Resources Management Officer (Logistics) (United States Army Human Resources Command (HRC), Fort Knox, Kentucky (AGR)); S3 (352nd Combat Sustainment Support Battalion, Macon, Georgia (AGR)); Company Commander (A/2-397/1/100th DIV (IT), Lexington, Kentucky (TPU)), Executive Officer (C/2-397/1/100th DIV (IT), Lexington, Kentucky (TPU) and the 257th Transportation Company (HET), Las Vegas, Nevada (TPU)), and Platoon Leader (427th Transportation Company (PLS), Norristown, Pennsylvania (TPU)). LTC Miller attained his Master's in Management from the University of Phoenix (2013) and a Bachelor of Business Administration, Computer Information Systems, from Eastern Kentucky University (1993). He is also a graduate of the Command & General Staff Officer College, Fort Leavenworth, KS (2016), the Combined Logistics Captain Career Course, Fort Lee, VA (2013), and the Transportation Officer Basic Course, Fort Eustis, VA (2003). Before transitioning to USAR AGR in 2010, he had the privilege of serving the citizens of Kentucky for 18 years in various technology-related positions, culminating in his last position as the Chief Technology Officer for the Administrative Office of the Courts.
