FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE HOME ASSOCIATION: First of all, I would like to thank all our members for supporting us during this 2020 COVID 19 pandemic crisis. I personally want to thank all our employees and manager for all the extra sacrifices that you have personally made for the Post. We had diligently tried to comply with all the mandates that have been placed on us by the Pennsylvania Department of Health and the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board. Those of you who come to our post will find that we have changed the canteen operation again to comply the latest COVID 19 restriction that was put into place by the PA Governor. All members and their guests must wear a facial covering when entering the Post; once you have been seated at a table, you can remove your facial covering. If you leave your table, you must have a facial covering on to enter the restrooms and/or exit the Post. It is a State Requirement that everyone seated at a table consuming any kind of alcohol must have food to be consumed. This new requirement took effect July 15, 2020; the Post is complying having had a Liquor Control Enforcement State Police Officer at the Post for inspection. We ask that you be patient to our servers during this crisis. This is a new endeavor that we must comply with which we never had to endure before, along with us understanding you have never had to endeavor a situation like this to come and enjoy our Post. For the good news: we have accomplished the following improvements to enhance a more pleasant atmosphere for your dining pleasure:

• No smoking policy effective January 1, 2020

- Installed a new Chicken Boaster in February 2020
- Completely refinished the bar in June 2020
- Completely redesigned the Bar and Dining Room for the COVID 19 Pandemic
